
1. Open a PoodLL Speaking Assignment


2. Read the Assignment task and make notes, the instructions will not be available in the recorder, then tap on the *Add submission* button

Invite a friend to ONE of the activities listed below. (You choose.)




3. Scroll down to the *Current submissions* area, notice that the PoodLL recorder is not supported by Android, tap on the big blue arrow in the *File submissions* area to add a file



4. Make sure *Upload a file* is selected in the file picker and then tap on the *Browse* or *Choose file* button to upload a file




5. Tap on the Camcorder button to open the recorder




6. Tap the camcorder icon to begin recording



7. When the recording is finished, tap on the repeat button to record again, tap on the play button to listen, and then tap on the check mark to upload the recording when it is done. Tap on the X button to delete the recording




8. The file will appear in the *Attachment* area, tap the *Upload this file* button to continue
