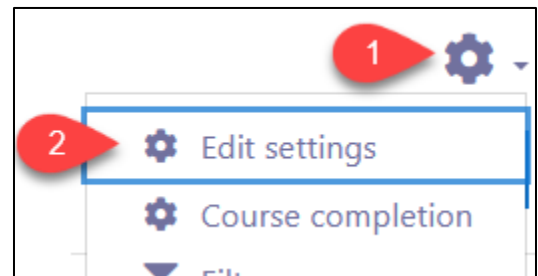


Showing and Hiding a Course

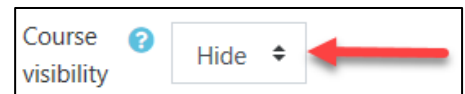
Courses can be hidden from students while they are being developed, updated, or during holidays. Your courses arrive in the hidden state. This allows new teachers to develop their courses in private. When the course is ready for a cohort of students, the teacher simply follows the instructions below to reveal the course to the students.

Showing your course to students

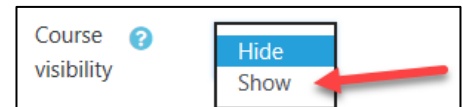
1. Click on the course **Actions** menu.
2. In the drop-down menu, click on **Edit settings**.



3. In the **General** section, click on the **Course visibility** box.



4. In the drop-down menu, click **Show**.



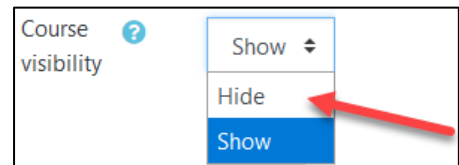
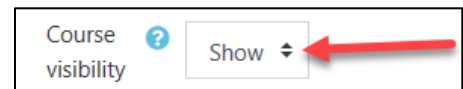
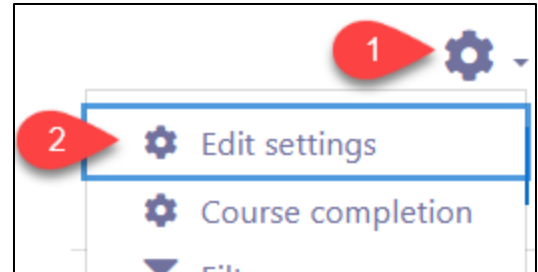
5. Scroll down and click **Save and display**.

Students now have access to the course

- Be aware that sometimes this access is not immediate; it may take an hour before students can see the course.

Hiding your course from your students

1. Click on the course **Actions** menu.
 2. Click on the **Actions** menu.
 3. In the drop-down menu, click on **Edit settings**.
 4. In the **General section**, click on the **Course visibility** box.
 5. Choose **Hide** in the drop-down menu.
 6. Click on the **Save and display** button.
- Students cannot see the course.
