Stage 2 Notes and Tips

Stage 2 can be completed online in about six to eight hours.

Tips from instructors who completed this training:

- 1. Try to cluster the time you spend on Stage 2, rather than spreading it out over a long period of time.
- 2. More intense focus such as a weekend or a PD day could be helpful.
- 3. Take point---form notes while viewing the movies.
- 4. Review a movie twice before attempting an assessment if needed.
- 5. Partner with another instructor to complete Stage 2.
- 6. Organize instructors completing Stage 2 at your work---site computer lab. (e.g. mornings, afternoons, PD Days, or on a weekend if possible.)
- 7. Contact your mentor via email with any questions or concerns.

Tips from the developers

- 8. Be aware of and read the News Forum at the top of the course. It may have information that can assist you.
- 9. The General Discussion Forum might be useful to read as you can learn from others' experience.
- 10. If there has been a delay since Stage One, it might be a good idea to review the concepts from Stage One through the PowerPoint or the Practical Review
- 11. During a Confidence Builder Quiz, you may not change your response after the Submit button has been pressed. You must continue the quiz and repeat if desired.
- 12. You must pass all Try it Yourself assessments and Confidence Builders with a score of 70% to pass Stage two.
- 13. It is recommended that you complete each topic (Instructional videos, Try it Yourself and a Confidence Builder) at one sitting.
- 14. When using the Try it Yourself simulations, be deliberate and reasonable when using the mouse. Clicking through in a reckless manner may lead to the simulation freezing up. In this case the participant must close the simulation and start over.
- 15. When re-attempting a guiz, check "Start a new attempt" and click "Enter".
