

How to Download a SCORM Object from Tutela.ca


Log in to Tutela.ca. (You need to sign up first.)

Step 1




In this example, we search for SCORM objects tagged as a listening item at the Canadian Language Benchmarks level 3. After searching, we can browse for a work-related item.






After completing **Step 5**, Tutela will only display those items that are "Online Activities (e.g. SCORM learning Objects)". If we browse the items now, only Online Activities/ SCORM resources are shown.






After completing Step 7, Tutela will display only those items that are "Online Activities (e.g. SCORM learning Objects)" and tagged for "listening."





Step 8




After completing Step 8, Tutela will display only those items that are tagged as "Online Activities (e.g. SCORM learning Objects)" for listening practice at the Canadian Language Benchmark level 3.




You have browsed the list of items in the search results and find something of interest.

Step 9





A page is displayed providing metadata and other information about that item. There is a link to display the item content.



If you want to add this item to your courseware, you must first download it to your local computer.

Step 10



After clicking the download the final few steps will vary slightly from web browser to web browser. Save this .ZIP file as you would an email attachment – somewhere easy to locate. (Do not unzip it.) Refer to the documentation in your learning management system for instructions on adding a SCORM object to a course. LearnIT2teach participants will find this in the Stage 3 training materials.
